CALIFORNIA CONSUMER PRIVACY STATEMENT

Effective: **January 1, 2020**

This California Consumer Privacy Statement supplements the [Website Privacy Policy](#) and applies solely to California consumers.

This Statement does not apply to (i) TPG personnel or job applicants seeking opportunities at TPG, (ii) personnel working on behalf of business partners with whom we are conducting business, or (iii) information collected, processed, sold or disclosed pursuant to the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (and its implementing regulations) or the California Financial Information Privacy Act.

This California Consumer Privacy Statement (the “Statement”) uses certain terms that have the meaning given to them in the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 and its implementing regulations (the “CCPA”).

1. Notice of Collection and Use of Personal Information

We may collect (and may have collected during the 12-month period prior to the effective date of this Statement) the following categories of personal information about you online or offline:

- **Identifiers:** identifiers such as a real name, alias, postal address, unique personal identifier (such as a device identifier; cookies, beacons, pixel tags; unique pseudonym or user alias; telephone number), online identifier, internet protocol address, email address, account name, Social Security number, driver’s license number, passport number, and other similar identifiers
- **Additional Data Subject to Cal. Civ. Code § 1798.80:** signature, physical characteristics or description, state identification card number, education, bank account number, credit card number, debit card number, and other financial information
- **Protected Classifications:** characteristics of protected classifications under California or federal law, such as race, color, national origin, age, sex, gender, gender identity, gender expression, sexual orientation, marital status, medical condition, disability, citizenship status, and military and veteran status
- **Commercial Information:** commercial or investment information, including records of personal property, financial products or investment services purchased, obtained, or considered, and other investing or consuming histories or tendencies
- **Online Activity:** Internet and other electronic network activity information, including, but not limited to, browsing history, search history, and information regarding your interaction with websites, applications or advertisements
- **Sensory Information:** audio, electronic, visual, and similar information
- **Employment Information:** professional or employment-related information
- **Inferences:** inferences drawn from any of the information identified above to create a profile about you reflecting your preferences, characteristics, psychological trends, predispositions, behavior, attitudes, intelligence, abilities, and aptitudes.

We may use (and may have used during the 12-month period prior to the effective date of this Statement) your personal information for the purposes described in the TPG Website Privacy Policy and for the following business purposes specified in the CCPA:

- Performing services, including maintaining or servicing accounts, providing customer service, processing or fulfilling orders and transactions, verifying customer information, processing payments, providing advertising or marketing services, providing analytics services, or providing similar services
- Auditing related to a current interaction with you and concurrent transactions, including, but not limited to, auditing compliance
- Short-term, transient use
- Detecting security incidents, protecting against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity, and prosecuting those responsible for that activity
- Debugging to identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality
- Undertaking internal research for technological development and demonstration
- Undertaking activities to verify or maintain the quality or safety of a service or device that is owned, manufactured, manufactured for, or controlled by us, and to improve, upgrade, or enhance the service or device that is owned, manufactured, manufactured for, or controlled by us

2. Sources of Personal Information

We may obtain (and may have obtained during the 12-month period prior to the effective date of this Statement), personal information about you from the following sources:

- From you, for example, through your use of our websites or mobile applications, when you send us an email, visit our facilities, or otherwise contact or communicate with us
- From monitoring tools, such as cookies that track your use of our websites or mobile applications and security cameras in certain of our facilities
- Our affiliates
- Our portfolio companies
- Businesses that we are evaluating in connection with a potential investment or business opportunity
- Vendors (e.g., background check providers), advisors and other business partners
- Recruiting agencies, social media networks or publicly available sources

3. Sharing of Personal Information

We may share (and may have shared during the 12-month period prior to the effective date of this Statement), your personal information with certain categories of third parties, as described below.

We may have disclosed the following categories of personal information about you for a business purpose to the following categories of third parties:

In addition to the categories of third parties identified above, during the 12-month period prior to the effective date of this Statement, we may have shared personal information about you with the following additional categories of third parties:

- Government entities, including regulatory agencies and law enforcement
- If you are a user of the TPG Events mobile application, your name and company name will be displayed within the application viewable to other event attendees

4. Sale of Personal Information

We do not sell personal information.

5. California Consumer Privacy Rights

You have certain choices regarding our use and disclosure of your personal information, as described below.

Access: You have the right to request, twice in a 12-month period, that we disclose to you the personal information we have collected, used, and disclosed about you during the past 12 months.

Deletion: You have the right to request that we delete certain personal information we have collected from you.

To submit a request as an authorized agent on behalf of a consumer, please send us an email at Privacy@tpg.com with your first name and a phone number at which may reach you and indicate in the subject line that you are making a CCPA Authorized Agent Request, or call 877-506-9084.

Verifying Requests: To help protect your privacy and maintain security, we will take steps to verify your identity before granting you access to your personal information or complying with your request. If you request access to or deletion of your personal information, we may require you to provide any of the following information: address, date of birth, unique personal identifier, nationality, telephone number, email address, CV information or details of a transaction. In addition, if you ask us to provide you with specific pieces of personal information, we will require you to sign a declaration under penalty of perjury that you are the consumer whose personal information is the subject of the request.

Additional Information: If you choose to exercise any of your rights under the CCPA, you have the right to not receive discriminatory treatment by us. To the extent permitted by applicable law, we may charge a reasonable fee to comply with your request. This Statement is available in alternative formats upon request.
